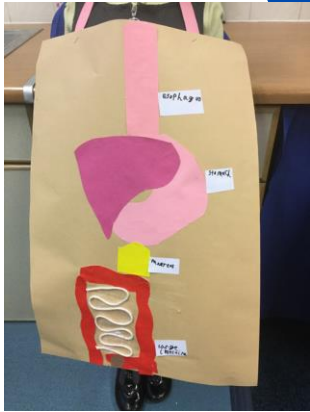

The Early Years Foundation Stage

In Nursery and Reception, children are in the Early Years Foundation Stage. During these years, children learn through an experiential, play-based curriculum which aims primarily to develop their social skills and communication with others.

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum to ensure that our curriculum offer is broad and balanced. We aim to fully involve parents in their child's education through workshops and stay and play sessions. Our Nursery and Reception provision is only one of a few across Warwickshire that has achieved the County inclusion kitemark award.

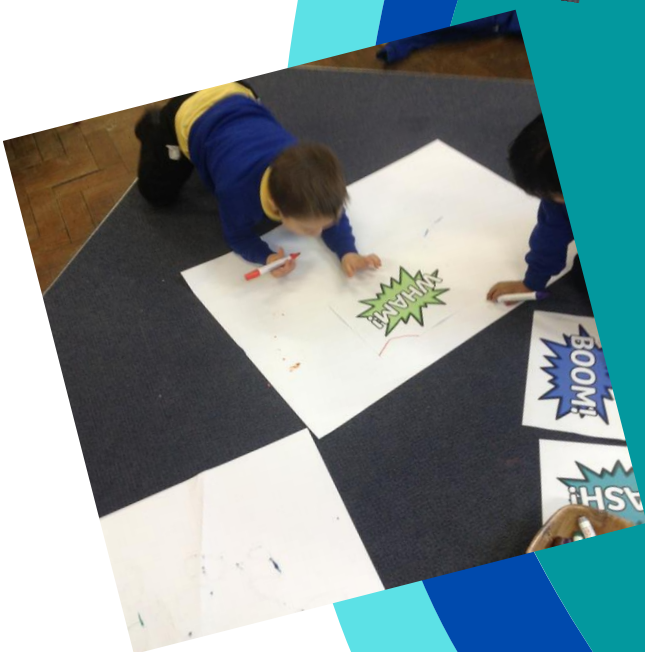


The journey continues

Key Stage One

As children move into Year 1 and Year 2, we follow the National Curriculum to provide a broad and balanced curriculum. We continue to offer experiential, first-hand experiences to develop children's cultural capital and further widen their vocabulary so that they are confident, capable communicators.

Children have the opportunity to take part in pupil leadership teams such as the School Council, as well as learn what it takes to be a 'Chilvers Champion' through assemblies and visits to other schools, places of worship and care homes.

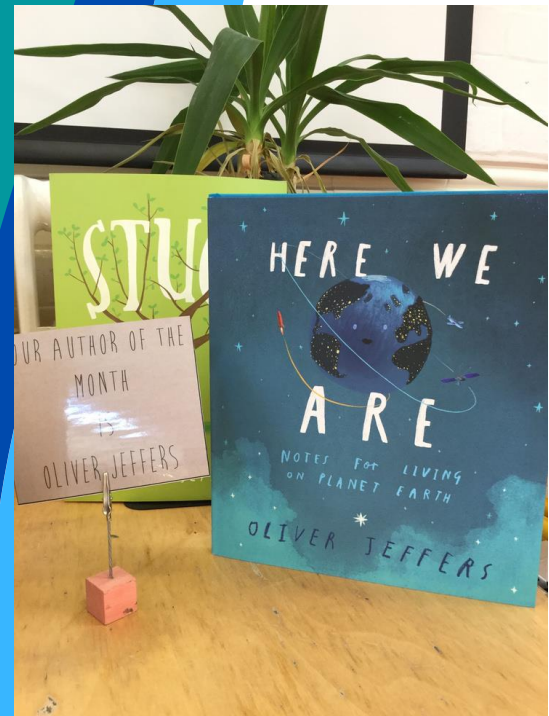
