As Geographers we will:

- Be exploring our local area of Nuneaton
- Go on walks in our local area
- Follow maps and routes to reach a given destination.
- Create our own simple maps of routes we have been on
- Explore human and physical features and identify these features within our local area.
- Understand what a symbol is and use symbols to create a key to identify key places on our own map
- Complete field work in our local area by observing our local surrounding environment
- Use data and observations to make decisions to improve our local area



As Scientists we will:

- Be learning all about our body
- Name the different parts of our bodies
- Label parts of our bodies including parts like elbow, shoulders, ankles and knees
- Identify what different parts of our bodies do
- Identify different parts of the body
- Explore the five senses
- Understand which body part is associated with each sense
- Identify what we use different senses for



As Citizens we will:

- Start to set simple goals and discuss things that we can do well
- Explore how we can achieve the goals that we set
- Discover and Explain how we learn best
- Develop our understanding of how to work well with a partner and celebrate our achievements together
- Tackle new challenges and understand challenges might stretch our learning
- Discuss how challenges make us feel.
- Talk about how 'obstacles' can make it difficult to achieve challenges and explore how we can overcome these obstacles
- Explore how we feel when we succeed



As Artists we will:

- Explore the artists Vanessa Brantley Newton and Brianna McCarthy
- Be focusing on self portraits
- Looking at different shapes focusing on circles, spirals, straight lines and curves
- Experiment drawing different facial features including eyes, mouths, noses and ears
- Develop shading techniques such as hatching and stippling to create different effects
- Sketching and drawing our own self portraits using all the new skills we have learned including drawing shapes and sketching.
- Add color onto our self portraits to create final pieces of art work
- Exploring using different mediums to draw including pencils, pastel, felt tips and cha

As Musicians we will:

- Understand what the pulse of a piece of music is
- Move to the pulse of pieces of music thinking about dynamics
- Compose a piece of music with different sounds
- Explore and understand how the pitch of music can change
- Understand what tempo is and how this can change a piece of music
- Follow a graphic score to play a piece of music
- Compose and then play our own music using a graphic score.



As Athletes we will:

- Explore and Develop basic gymnastic actions on the floor and apparatus.
- Develop our basic skills of jumping, rolling, balancing and travelling.
- Build short sequences of movements combining travelling and linking different shapes.
- Develop our skills in rolling and throwing different sized balls towards a target
- Send and receive balls with different parts of the body developing tracking skills.
- Throw and catch different sized balls over different distances adapting how we throw a ball for a short distance compared to a long distance
- Apply the sending and receiving skills we have developed in small games.



As Technologists we will:

- Continue to log in and out
- Develop our mouse and keyboard skills and locate certain keys on the keyboard
- Start to explore the software 'Purple Mash'
- Explore where tools are on 'Purple Mash'
- Use different paint tools to create our own pictures
- Creating our own Jigsaws which we can play



As Theologists we will:

- Explore the Religion of Judaism
- Talk about Theologists our favourite days of the week and say why it is special
- Retell the creation story and explore how it relates to the Sabbath
- Discover 'Shabbat' and explain how 'Shabbat' is celebrated.
- Talk about why Jewish families might go to a synagogue to celebrate Shabbat.
- Explore what happens on 'Shabbat'

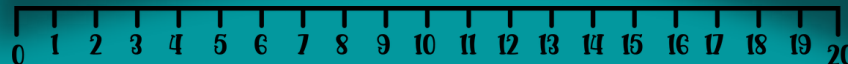

As Mathematicians we will:

- Count within 20
- Understand 10
- Understand teen numbers 11-19
- Understand 20
- Explore 1 more and 1 less to numbers to 20
- Explore, use and estimate the number line to 20
- Compare numbers to 20 using the language less than, greater than, equal to as well as using the symbols $<$ $>$ $=$
- Order numbers to 20 using the language greatest and smallest
- Add by counting on within 20
- Add and Subtract ones by using number bonds
- Find and make number bonds to 20
- Find doubles and near doubles
- Subtract by counting back
- Subtract by finding the difference
- Find related facts
- Solve missing number problems



As Writers we will:

- Think, Say and remember sentences that start with a time word
- Use time adverbials - First, Next, Then, After That, Finally.
- Secure the use of Capital Letters, Full Stops and Finger spaces when writing sentences.
- Use adjectives to describe a noun (size and colour).
- Use the past tense
- Write in Chronological order
- Start to use story language such as Once Upon a time/ One Sunny Day
- Ensure our writing includes a beginning, middle and end
- Create Riddles for different animals, using the present tense
- Start to use conjunctions such as and
- Create a set of instructions using numbered steps and bullet points
